A RESOLUTION EXTENDING DEEPEST SYMPATHY AND CONDOLENCES TO THE FAMILY OF THE LATE MELCHOR VERGEL DE DIOS WHO DIED LAST APRIL 20, 2006 IN A CAR PARKED AT EVER GOTESCO MALL, COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, two men, one of them a fashion designer, were found dead and hogtied inside a car parked at Ever Gotesco mall, Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City last April 26, 2006;

WHEREAS, one of the victims was identified as one Melchor Vergel De Dios, a quiet, soft-spoken man with no vices, president of 1170 Garments Corporation and a known fashion designer;

WHEREAS, the untimely death of the late Melchor Vergel De Dios is a big loss to the fashion industry not only to the Philippines but also of the whole world.

NOW, THEREFORE,


