RESOLUTION NO. SP-3418, S-2006
(PR2006-251)

A RESOLUTION CONDEMNING THE RECENT SPATE OF VIOLENCE IN QUEZON CITY PARTICULARLY THE SENSELESS MURDER OF MELCHOR VERGEL DE DIOS, A RENOWNED FASHION DESIGNER, AND URGING THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE THROUGH THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT TO CURB THE RISE OF CRIMINALITY IN QUEZON CITY AND CALLING FOR THE SPEEDY INVESTIGATION OF SUCH HEINOUS ACT.

WHEREAS, two men, one of them a fashion designer, were found dead and hogtied inside a car parked at Ever Gotesco Mall, Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City last April 26, 2006;

WHEREAS, one of the victims was identified as one Melchor Vergel De Dios, a quiet, soft-spoken man with no vices, president of 1170 Garments Corporation and a known fashion designer;


WHEREAS, a cursory examination of the body of Vergel De Dios showed that a white plastic bag had been placed over his head, a galvanized iron wire around his neck while the hands were tied behind his back and bruises in the head and body.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to condemn, as it does hereby condemn, the senseless murder of Melchor Vergel De Dios and urging the Philippine National Police through the Quezon City Police District to curb the rise of criminality in Quezon City and calling further for the speedy investigation of such heinous act.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Philippine National Police through the Quezon City Police District.
