WHEREAS, at present, Batino Elementary School, Project 3, Quezon City is in need of a classroom building that will cater numerous students under Special Education class;


WHEREAS, there is a need for the said construction in view of the number of students who could be benefited thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE,


