A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT AND COMMISERATING WITH THE VICTIMS OF SUPER TYPHOON "REMING" IN THE BICOL REGION AND OTHER AFFECTED AREAS.

WHEREAS, as of last tally, the total casualty count, which includes provinces in the Bicol Region and Southern Luzon, stood at 425 dead, with 599 missing, and 507 injured. The Red Cross said that with hundreds of people still missing, and perhaps with entire families buried under the mud, the final death toll could exceed 1,000;

WHEREAS, Bicol Region, which is the worst affected area, suffered innumerable deaths and destruction to properties;

WHEREAS, according to the National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC), super typhoon "Reming" damaged 250.91 million pesos worth of agricultural products and another 23.20 million pesos worth of infrastructure. The NDCC said a total of 1,094,218 have been affected by the mudslides and floods;


WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for Quezon City to commiserate with the victims of typhoon "Reming" and to provide any form of assistance, whether financial or logistical, in order to alleviate the pain and suffering of the victims in the Bicol Region and other affected areas;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to express, as it does hereby express, support and commiserate with the victims of super typhoon "Reming" in Bicol Region and other affected areas.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC) and the National Red Cross, for their information.
