RESOLUTION NO. SP-**3713**, S-2007

A RESOLUTION URGING THE MAJOR AUTOMOBILE MANUFACTURERS TO CONDUCT TESTS TO DETERMINE THE POSSIBLE ILL EFFECTS TO HEALTH AND THE LONG TERM PERFORMANCE OF THE AUTOMOBILE ENGINE FROM THE USE OF LIQUEFIED PETROLBUM GAS AS AN ALTERNATIVE FUEL SOURCE.

WHEREAS, due to the prices of petroleum products, taxi operators and private vehicle owners are resorting to cheaper alternative fuel sources such as Liquefied Petroleum Gas;

WHEREAS, some of the residents of Quezon City have complained of nausea and headache after riding taxis using such Liquefied Petroleum Gas as their fuel;

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the local government of Quezon City to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants, particularly their health and safety;



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the officials of the major automobile manufacturers to conduct research and test of the possible ill effects to the health of the passengers and the performance of the automobile engine from the use of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas as an alternative fuel source.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
