
RESOLUTION REQUESTING ALL PUNONG BARANGAYS IN-QUEZON CITY, TO POST BARANGAY SECURITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICER (BSDO) PERSONNEL TO MAN PEDESTRIAN OVERPASSES WHICH WERE CONSTRUCTED WITHIN THEIR AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY.

WHEREAS, overpasses are constructed to address traffic congestion, which lessen pedestrian movement thereby resulting to a smooth vehicular traffic flow;

WHEREAS, it has been reported that crime syndicate are using pedestrian overpasses as their place for the commission of crimes such as rampant cellphone and bag snatching, hold ups and petty thieveries;

WHEREAS, it is proper and fitting that to prevent such crimes, it is urgently necessary to request all barangay captains to post their BSDO personnel to man all overpasses installed in their area in order to deter the commission of crimes by unknown persons.
