A RESOLUTION REQUESTING EVERY SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY IN QUEZON CITY, TO ALLOCATE REASONABLE FUNDS FROM ITS ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FEEDING AND NUTRITION PROGRAM BEING CONDUCTED BY BARANGAY NUTRITION SCHOLARS FOR BELOW NORMAL WEIGHT PRESCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN IN THE BARANGAY.

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution states that "the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, the City government being an instrument of the State, adheres and adopts this policy to protect the general welfare of the people;

WHEREAS, health welfare is one of the fundamental responsibilities of local government units toward its constituents as embodied in the Local Government Code;

WHEREAS, proper and adequate feeding and nutrition is a basic pre-requisite for normal health of an individual from birth, early middle and late childhood and through adolescence and adulthood;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the health welfare mandate of the Local Government Code (Republic Act 7160), the Quezon City Health Department, with the support of the City government, has organized and trained its volunteer Barangay Nutrition Scholars in conducting Feeding and Nutrition Programs for below normal weight preschool-age children in most, if not all, of the barangays in the City;


WHEREAS, these Feeding and Nutrition Programs, in order to be ongoing in the Barangays with maximum productivity and successful outcome, the Barangay Nutrition Scholars need the material assistance of the Sangguniang Barangay for adequate and continually available feeding and nutrition supplies as may be specified by these Barangay Nutrition Scholars;

WHEREAS, every Sangguniang Barangay in Quezon City can possibly allocate reasonable funds from its annual budget in support and sustenance of Feeding and Nutrition programs for below normal weight preschool-age children in the Barangay.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, every Sangguniang Barangay in Quezon City, to allocate reasonable funds from its annual budget for the Feeding and Nutrition Program being conducted by Barangay Nutrition Scholars for below normal weight preschool-age children in the barangay.


