(PR2006-494)

A RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TO CONDUCT TESTS REGARDING THE POSSIBLE EFFECTS TO THE HEALTH AND THE PERFORMANCE OF THE AUTOMOBILE ENGINE OF THE USE OF LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS INSTEAD OF REGULAR GASOLINE IN TAXIS AND PRIVATE VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the local government of Quezon City to promote the health and safety of its inhabitants;



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Secretaries of the Department of Health, Department of Transportation and Communication and the Department of Science and Technology to conduct tests to determine the possible ill effects to the health and the performance of the automobile engine of the use of Liquefied Petroleum Gas as an alternative fuel source.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
