A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., AND PANGEA GREEN ENERGY S.R.L. AND PANGEA GREEN ENERGY PHILIPPINES, INC., FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEAN-UP ACTIVITIES AT THE PAYATAS CONTROLLED DUMP FACILITY.

WHEREAS, as a pioneer local government unit in the solid waste disposal operation in the country, the Quezon City government will again embark on another breakthrough project at the Payatas Controlled Dump Facility under the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) project;

WHEREAS, a previous study by the Philippine National Oil Company revealed that the Payatas Controlled Dump Facility is highly qualified as CDM project because of the big volume of methane gas that it has been generating since the time it was first utilized up to the present;

WHEREAS, the implementation of environmental clean-up activities at the Payatas Controlled Dump Facility which shall involve the application of appropriate technologies for the extraction, collection and processing, including the conversion into electricity of the biogas emissions at the facility, also known as the Quezon City Controlled Disposal Facility Biogas Reduction Project;


WHEREAS, this project will be the first of its kind in the country, making Quezon City again as the pioneering local government unit for environmental protection;

WHEREAS, if seen the effectiveness of this pilot project and aware of the countless benefits this type of project will bring in terms of social, financial and technological opportunities, the approval of this resolution is in order.
