*WHEREAS, Quezon City is home to more than 500 established  
cooperatives which are partners of the City government in fostering the  
creation and growth of cooperatives as a practical vehicle for  
promoting self-reliance and harnessing people power towards the  
attainment of economic development and social justice;*

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 35 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Quezon City government may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people's and non-government organizations to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capacity-building and livelihood projects, and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to declare, as it does hereby declare, October of every year as "Quezon City Cooperative Month (QCCM)."
