**RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE EXISTENCE OF THE QUEZON CITY URBAN POOR COUNCIL OF LEADERS (QC-COL), AND GRANTING ACCREDITATION HEREON.**

*WHEREAS, it is the policy of the state to encourage non-governmental, community-based, or sectoral organizations that promote the welfare of the nation;*

*WHEREAS, Article XIII, Social Justice and Human Rights, Sections 15 and 16, of the Constitution recognizes the role and rights of people's organizations as vehicles to enable the people to participate and intervene meaningfully and effectively in decisions which directly affect their lives;*

*WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991", the City is mandated to promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations, NGOs and the private sector to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy, particularly in the implementation of projects, programs and activities;*

*WHEREAS, R.A. 7160, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, require the City Council to call all community-based people and non-government organizations, civil society and private sector organizations, including business and professional groups to apply for accreditation with the City Council for possible membership in the local special bodies.*


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to recognize, as it does hereby recognize, and approve the existence of the Quezon City Urban Poor Council of Leaders (QC-COL) as partners of the City government in the creation, promotion and sustainable development of the urban poor movement in Quezon City.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, to request the City Vice Mayor, to issue forthwith the Certificate of Accreditation to the Quezon City Urban Poor Council of Leaders (QC-COL) and authorize the Board of Directors of QC-COL and the City Mayor as co-signatories, duly attested by the City Secretary;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the copy of this Resolution be furnished to the City Mayor and the USEC/Chairman of Presidential Commission for the Urban Poor, for their information and appropriate action.
