RESOLUTION NO. SP-**3768**, S-2007
(PR2007-65)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RESIDENTS OF JERSEY AND STA. GERTRUDES STREETS, BARANGAY BAHAY TORO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, TO INSTALL MANNED GATES AT STRATEGIC ENTRANCES, FOR SECURITY AND CONTROL PURPOSES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160.

Introduced by Councilors VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., JORGE B. BANAL, JR., RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, ERIC Z. MEDINA and ANTONIO E. INTON, JR.

WHEREAS, Section 21 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise referred to as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the local government of Quezon City, to temporarily close local roads at reasonable hours:

"SECTION 21. Closure and Opening of Roads. - (a) A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park or square falling within its jurisdiction . . . ;"

WHEREAS, the construction or installation of manned outposts or gates at strategic entrances to Jersey and Sta. Gertrudes Street, Barangay Bahay Toro, District I, Quezon City, would discourage the criminally-inclined to perpetrate their criminal designs, especially at night, knowing that these manned outposts or gates will militate against their depredations;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid manned outposts or gates will promote peace and order, protect life and property and redound to the safety, security and convenience, not only of the residents of Jersey and Sta. Gertrudes Streets but also of the public in general;

WHEREAS, said security gates shall be closed only during critical hours, from 11:00 o'clock in the evening until 5:00 o'clock in the morning and, in any case, shall allow the ingress and egress of pedestrians and vehicles in times of emergency at any hour of night or day.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the residents of Jersey and Sta. Gertrudes Streets in Barangay Bahay Toro, District I, Quezon City, to construct, install, man and maintain at their expense, security outposts or gates at strategic entrances to said thoroughfares.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the gates shall be kept open for free passage from 5:00 o'clock in the morning until 11:00 o'clock in the evening, to be manned by private security guards who will be hired by the residents of Jersey and Sta. Gertrudes Streets. However, in case of emergency, whether man-made or brought about by a fortuitous event, the residents of nearby communities shall be allowed passage in said gates, regardless of the time the passage is sought.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the residents of Jersey and Sta. Gertrudes Streets shall comply strictly with the provisions of this Resolution. Any deviation from the terms hereof shall cause the nullification of the authority granted them, subject to the right of notice and hearing.
