RESOLUTION NO. SP-**3796**, S-2007
(PR2006-37/PR2007-38)

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE JANUARY 23, 2007 VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT GUTTED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF MORE OR LESS ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE (185) FAMILIES LOCATED AT WARAY COMPOUND, AREA 5 AND AREA 6, BARANGAY BOTOCAN, QUEZON CITY, AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council is empowered under Section 458 (a), (1), (iv) of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the City from the harmful effects of manmade or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disaster or calamities, and their return to productive livelihood following said events."

WHEREAS, these unfortunate fire victims need the assistance of the City government in the form of financial aid to defray the cost of the building materials for the reconstruction of their houses, purchase of foods, clothing and other necessary expenses at the sum of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) for each house owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) for each house renter/sharer;

WHEREAS, because of this unfortunate incident, the One Hundred Eighty-Five (185) families who are presently in makeshift dwellings can only hope and pray for the early release of financial assistance from the City government.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to extend financial assistance to the January 23, 2007 victims of the fire that gutted the residential houses of more or less One Hundred Eighty-Five (185) families located at Waray Compound, Area 5 and Area 6, Barangay Botocan, Quezon City at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer which shall be taken from the calamity or emergency fund of the City government or from any available funds of the city.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department (SSDD), shall validate and authenticate the list of the fire victims categorized into family owner, family renter/sharer and to submit the same to the Office of the City Mayor likewise making representation for the early release of the financial assistance to the qualified recipients.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Office of the City Mayor shall revalidate and confirm the list submitted by the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) which will be the basis for the preparation of the payroll and to approve the immediate release of the funds allocated for the purpose.


