RESOLUTION NO. SP-**3801**, S-2007
(PR2007-59)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE SENTRO NG MANGGAGAWANG PILIPINA AND HEIFER INTERNATIONAL FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MULTI-AGRICULTURAL PERI-URBAN LIVELIHOOD PROGRAM (MAPULP) IN SELECTED URBAN POOR AREAS IN QUEZON CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P1,600,000.00) AS THE INITIAL COUNTERPART FUND/SHARE OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Sentro ng Manggagawang Pilipina (SENTRO) is a Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC)-registered and Gender Development – Quezon City (GAD-QC)-accredited non-government organization whose advocacies include espousing the welfare of overseas workers, platform of action for women through gender equality, and similar concerns;

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its mission of uplifting the human rights, economic, health, and overall well-being of the members of the marginalized sector of our society, SENTRO, in partnership with the Sangguniang Barangay of Greater Fairview of Quezon City has established the Multi-Agricultural Peri-Urban Livelihood Program – MAPULP for brevity – which shall have the following component, viz: Horticulture, Livestock, Agriculture, Skills Training, Values Formation/Education. The MAPULP project is guided by the concept/principle of PASS-ON-THE-GIFT (POG) wherein one group beneficiaries are obliged to share with the next beneficiaries the fruits from the project as to ensure the sustainability and continuity;


WHEREAS, as the pilot area for the implementation of the MAPULP Project, forty (40) families in Barangay Greater Fairview have been identified and are presently undergoing education/training phase preparatory to their actual involvement as beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, as partner proponent of SENTRO in the MAPULP Project, HEIFER International has provided a funding of Two Million Forty Two Thousand Five Hundred Eighty Pesos (P2,042,580.00) for a three (3) year period anchored on the condition that the Local Government concerned (i.e. Quezon City Government) provide a counterpart fund to sustain the project in other depressed areas of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Sentro ng Manggagawang Pilipina, Inc. (SENTRO) and Heifer International for the implementation of the Multi-Agricultural Peri-Urban Livelihood Program (MAPULP) in selected urban poor areas in Quezon City and also authorizing the City Mayor to release the amount of One Million Six Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1,600,000.00) as the initial counterpart fund/share of the City.
