RESOLUTION NO. SP-**3819**, S-2007
(PR2007-133)

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF CALAMITY IN THE ENTIRE QUEZON CITY IN VIEW OF THE DEVASTATION CAUSED BY TYPHOON MILENYO ON 28 AND 29 SEPTEMBER 2006 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO USE THE CALAMITY FUND AND TAKE ALL THE APPROPRIATE AND NECESSARY EMERGENCY MEASURES IN RESPONSE THEREOF.

Introduced by Councilor ANTONIO E. INTON, JR.

WHEREAS, typhoon Milenyo, the strongest typhoon ever recorded by PAGASA on 28 and 29 September 2006, directly hit Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the strong winds brought by typhoon Milenyo caused the severance of communication and power lines. Likewise, the strong winds brought about the uprooting of trees and the scattering of billboards and other debris which caused the obstruction of the major public thoroughfares, streets and premises of houses, private and public buildings;

WHEREAS, in response to the damages/devastations that may be caused by calamities such as the foregoing, the City has appropriated in its annual budget 5% of the estimated revenue from regular resources, mandated by the Local Government Code, as annual lump sum appropriation for relief and rehabilitation that may be used for unforeseen events caused by the occurrence of calamities.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to declare, as it does hereby declare, the entire Quezon City in a State of Calamity.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., is hereby authorized to take such emergency measures in response to the destruction/damages, such as the obstruction brought about by the scattering of uprooted trees, branches, billboards and other debris in major thoroughfares, and such other action, as may be appropriate in the prevention or control of any damage and/or outbreak of disease that may possibly transpire as a result of Typhoon Milenyo, all chargeable against the Calamity Fund.
