A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO CREATE A TASK FORCE INVOLVING ALL TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT AND MANAGEMENT AGENCIES THAT WILL EFFECTIVELY, DECISIVELY AND STRICTLY IMPLEMENT TRAFFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS ALONG COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilors BERNADETTE HERRERA DY, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., FRANCISCO A. CALALAY, JR., ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS and JOSEPH P. JUICO.

WHEREAS, Commonwealth Avenue is now known as the most dangerous street not only in Quezon City but in the entire Philippines;

WHEREAS, thousand of vehicular accidents particularly, due to over speeding and reckless driving, have occurred along Commonwealth Avenue that resulted to deaths and injuries to hundreds of people and will not stop unless and until discipline and traffic rules and regulations are strictly enforced therein;

WHEREAS, it is now high time that appropriate, decisive and effective government action be taken along Commonwealth Avenue in order to prevent further loss of lives and injuries.
