RESOLUTION NO. SP-**3866**, S-2007
(PR2007-91)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO JKL SHELL SERVICES STATION FOR THE OPERATION OF A GASOLINE SERVICE STATION LOCATED AT 1081 QUIRINO HIGHWAY, BARANGAY KALIGAYAHAN, NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilors WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, AIKO MELENDEZ-JICKAIN, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. and BAYANI V. HIPOL.

WHEREAS, the petitioner JKL Shell Services Station is applying for the issuance of a Special Use Permit (SUP) for the operation of a gasoline service station located at 1081 Quirino Highway, Barangay Kaligayahan, Novaliches, Quezon City, classified as major commercial zone;

WHEREAS, gasoline service station is among the uses which require a Special Use Permit upon authorization from the Quezon City Council as provided for in the Ordinance No. SP-918, otherwise known as the "Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance" of 2002;

WHEREAS, petitioner JKL Shell Services, has complied with the necessary requirements in securing and issuance of a Special Use Permit as required by Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000;


WHEREAS, the grant of Special Use Permit will promote public welfare and economic development through its increase employment opportunities in Quezon City, provided that the said petitioner shall comply with existing ordinance and other special laws on the matter.
