*WHEREAS, a Deed of Donation will be given to the recipients transferring the ownership, encumbrances and dues of the said vehicles thereby authorizing them to appropriate funds for the payment of insurance and registration of the said vehicles from their respective budgets.*

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to donate, as it does hereby donate, the forty five (45) units of multi-cab vehicles to the above mentioned recipients as part of the Peace and Order Campaign of Quezon City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that ownership of the said vehicles be transferred to the recipients through a Deed of Donation to be signed by the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, the Office of Councilor Joseph P. Juico as the main proponent and the Office of the City General Services Office (CGSO) represented by Mr. Rolando P. Montiel;

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that the recipients be authorized to appropriate funds for the payment of insurance and registration of these vehicles from their respective budgets;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution along with the Deed of Donation be given to the forty five (45) recipients, the Office of the City Mayor, the City General Services Office and the Office of Councilor Joseph P. Juico for future reference.
