RESOLUTION NO. SP- **5009** S-2010

A RESOLUTION ADDRESSING THE EXISTING DENGUE PROBLEM BY ENJOINING ALL THE BARANGAYS TO RAISE AWARENESS OF THE COMMUNITY THROUGH CONDUCTING MASSIVE INFORMATION CAMPAIGN AND TO REDUCE CASES OF DENGUE BY PROCURING MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT USING AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE BARANGAY.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 under Sections 16 and 17 of Book 1, Chapter 1 provides that each Local Government unit shall ensure the efficient delivery of basic services, including among others, adequate health and social welfare services and facilities to its constituents;

WHEREAS, dengue is now considered by the World Health Organization as a year round threat because of the rising temperature and the unpredictable change of weather, and past experiences of the City dictates that Dengue cases rapidly increase during the rainy season;

WHEREAS, the City Council is enjoining all the barangays to be vigilant in the existing Dengue problem and is urged to ensure preparedness in emergency situations in relation thereto. To immediately institute precautionary measures to battle Dengue by conducting massive information campaign to raise the level of awareness among the city residents, by procuring medical supplies to reduce cases of dengue and organizing clean-up program and if necessary fogging within their respective territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, such procurement may be undertaken through the disbursement of any available funds of the barangay.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SPECIAL SESSION ASSEMBLED, to address, as it does hereby address the existing dengue problem by enjoining all the Barangays to raise awareness of the community through conducting massive information campaign and to reduce cases of dengue by procuring medical supplies and equipment using available funds of the Barangay.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the concerned agencies of the City Government.
