RESOLUTION NO. SP- **5023**, S-2010

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO IMPLEMENT QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-1173, S-2002 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SUM OF ONE MILLION PESOS (P1,000,000.00) FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY FOR THE REPRODUCTION OF THE MONUMENT OR SHRINE OF PRESIDENT MANUEL LUIS QUEZON IN THE QUEZON CITY HALL TO BE ERECTED WITHIN THE COMPOUND OF NOVALICHES DISTRICT CENTER (NDC), ALSO KNOWN AS THE NOVALICHES MINI CITY HALL".

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2002, the Quezon City Council has enacted Ordinance No. SP-1173, S-2002 approving the sum of (P1,000,000.00) for the reproduction of the monument of President Manuel Luis Quezon in the Quezon City Hall to be erected within the compound of Novaliches District Center (NDC), also known as the Novaliches Mini City Hall, and the same was approved by then City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr.;

WHEREAS, being the founder of Quezon City, it is appropriate that the monument or shrine of President Manuel Luis Quezon be erected within the compound where an official building or offices of the city government are located, not just to perpetuate his memory, but to continually instill to the minds of the city residents his heroism and good deeds that greatly contributed to the growth and development of Quezon City;


WHEREAS, Novaliches District Center (NDC), also known as Novaliches Mini City Hall, where the proposed monument is to be erected, is a branch of Quezon City Hall established to hasten the delivery of public services to the people of Novaliches;

WHEREAS, the installation or erection of the monument of President Manuel Luis Quezon in NDC will make the residents of Novaliches feel that they truly belong to Quezon City and that the city government is bent on improving their lives.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to implement Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-1173, S-2002 entitled "An Ordinance approving the sum of One Million Pesos (P1,000,000.00) from any available funds of the City Treasury for the reproduction of the Monument or Shrine of President Manuel Luis Quezon in the Quezon City Hall to be erected within the compound of Novaliches District Center (NDC), also known as the Novaliches Mini City Hall.
