RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5051, S-2010

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY AND UNANIMOUSLY URGING HIS EXCELLENCY, PRESIDENT BENIGNO SIMEON AQUINO III, HOUSE SPEAKER FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., SENATOR VICENTE SOTTO III, SENATOR FRANCIS PANGILINAN, SENATOR MIRIAM DEFENSOR-SANTLAGO, REPRESENTATIVES VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, WINSTON T. CASTELO, AND JORGE B. BANAL, JR. AND ALL OTHER NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS RESIDING IN QUEZON CITY TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAINING SCHOOL BUILDING AT THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (PUP), COMMONWEALTH BRANCH, BARANGAY COMMONWEALTH, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is hereby declared the policy of the Quezon City Government to promote and make accessible the quality education to all level of life;

WHEREAS, PUP offers three (3) collegiate courses and other vocational courses;

WHEREAS, PUP lacks the necessary infrastructure facility to house additional students, although its graduates are only about 500 students per school year;


WHEREAS, there has been a long felt need for the establishment of a training school building at the Polytechnic University of the Philippines, Barangay Commonwealth which will cater not only the residents of the barangay but also to the adjoining and neighboring barangays and would help the poor residents acquire quality education;

WHEREAS, it is now high time that the government provide opportunities to the residents for vocational courses which will train them for employment and livelihood development in order to uplift their living conditions.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly and unanimously urge his Excellency, President Benigno Simeon Aquino III, House Speaker Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., Senator Vicente Sotto III, Senator Francis Pangilinan, Senator Miriam Defensor-Santiago, Representatives Vincent P. Crisologo, Winston T. Castelo, Jorge B. Banal, Jr. and all other National Government Officials residing in Quezon City to appropriate funds for the construction of a Training School Building at the Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP), Commonwealth Branch, Barangay Commonwealth, Quezon City.


