**A RESOLUTION URGING ALL DEPARTMENTS, OFFICES AND UNITS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO RE-USE PAPERS IN PRINTING INTERNAL COMMUNICATIONS WITHOUT NECESSARILY SACRIFICING THE READABILITY OF THE LETTER CONTENT.**

*WHEREAS, according to studies an average Filipino generates 0.3 and 0.5 kg. of solid waste daily in rural and urban areas, respectively;*

*WHEREAS, the National Capital Region (NCR), where Quezon City is located, accounts for twenty-three percent (23%) of the total solid waste generated in the country annually;*

*WHEREAS, the National Solid Waste Management Commission reported that sixteen percent (16%) of the total solid waste generated were classified as paper waste;*

*WHEREAS, the City Government uses paper in its daily transactions and incidentally produces those that back portions which can still be utilized or commonly termed as "scratch papers";*

*WHEREAS, the said back portions can be used for inter-office memorandums or communications if the readability thereof will not be affected;*

*WHEREAS, this simple and daily effort to contribute in the ecological solid waste management will go a long way considering the recent calamities the country experienced due to environmental problems;*

*WHEREAS, the City Council should enact measures that will initiate action and active participation by the city government employees;*

*WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the city legislators to give importance and significantly contribute in the process of saving our environment.*

*NOW, THEREFORE,*

*BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge all departments, offices and units of the Quezon City Government to re-use papers in printing internal communications without necessarily sacrificing the readability of the letter content.*
