A RESOLUTION URGING THE METRO MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA) TO STRENGTHEN THEIR DRIVE ON CLEANING AND DECLOGGING OF CANALS PARTICULARLY IN QUEZON CITY TO PREVENT THE OUTBREAK OF DENGUE AND OTHER RELATED DISEASES.
