RESOLUTION NO. SP-___5070___, S-2011

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTION TO FIANCHETTO REALTY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 4-STOREY, 10-UNIT TOWNHOUSES WITH PROMENADE, LOCATED AT NO.3 ROAD 17, BARANGAY BAHAY TORO, PROJECT 8, QUEZON CITY, COVERED BY TRANFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NO. 004-2010000401 OF THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS OF QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE DENSITY REQUIREMENT AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER THE QUEZON CITY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. SP-918, S-2000, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, Fianchetto Realty Development Corporation, a juridical entity duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws which engaged primarily in the development and construction of housing projects, with principal office address at Unit 1, Villa Felicidad, No. 117, 14th Avenue. Cubao, Quezon City, has a project for the construction of an affordable residential 10 units of 4-storey townhouses at No. 3 Road 17, Barangay Bahay Toro, Project 8, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Fianchetto Realty Development Corporation, through its President Cesar M. Ilagan, has submitted an application for the issuance of a Certificate of Exception necessary for the aforesaid project with the City Council, in conformity with the provision of the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, as amended, and has complied with the requirements for the issuance thereof;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Bahay Toro, Project 8 Quezon City, through its issued Barangay Clearance, and the residents therein interposed no objection to the said construction of an affordable residential 10 units of 4-storey townhouses;

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WHEREAS, Fianchetto Realty Development Corporation's application for a Certificate of Exception is meritorious taking into consideration the following;

- 1. The exception will not adversely affect public health, safety and welfare and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community;
- 2. The proposed project shall support economic-based activities and provide livelihood, vital community services and facilities and at the same time, poses no adverse effect on the zone or community;
- 3. The exception will not adversely affect the appropriate use of the adjoining properties in the same district; and
- 4. The exception will not alter the essential character and general purpose of the district where the exception sought to be authorized is located;

WHEREAS, the applicant has complied with and is further ready, able, and willing to comply with all the prescribed requirements relative thereto, pursuant to and in keeping with the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant the issuance of a Certificate of Exception to Fianchetto Realty Development Corporation for the construction of a 4-storey, 10- unit townhouses with promenade, located at No. 3 Road 17, Barangay Bahay Toro, Project 8, Quezon City, allowing deviation from the density requirement and other restrictions provided under the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance NO. SP-918, S-2000, as amended.
