RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5086, S-2011

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO HIS EXCELLENCY PRESIDENT BENIGNO SIMEON C. AQUINO III AND THE SECRETARY OF NATIONAL DEFENSE TO STUDY THE TRANSFER OF CAMP GENERAL EMILIO AGUINALDO AND CAMP CRAME FROM QUEZON CITY TO ANOTHER LESS POPULATED PLACE OUTSIDE OF METROPOLITAN MANILA.

CRISOLOGO, PRECIOUS HIPOLITO CASTELO, JULIENNE ALYSON RAE V. MEDALLA, RODERICK M. PAULATE, JESSICA CASTELO DAZA, RAQUEL S. MALAÑGEN and JOHN ANSELL R. DE GUZMAN.

WHEREAS, Camp General Emilio Aguinaldo and Camp Crame are military camps where military personnel and armed men are stationed, and where military ammunitions, bombs, and other explosive materials and equipment are likely stored;

WHEREAS, the said military camps are located within the heart of Quezon City, a densely populated urban metropolis, hence, their presence in the center of the city are high risk to the people living within the vicinity who may likely be innocent victims in the midst of conflict of military forces in the event that military operations are conducted against said camps by a foreign adversary or any other hostile armed groups, or conflagration may originate from said camps when the ammunitions, bombs and other materials stored therein are deliberately or accidentally ignited;

WHEREAS, there is a felt need, therefore, to remove said military camps where they are presently situated and to transfer them to another less populated area outside Metropolitan Manila to avoid the possibility of loss of lives and damage to property which may incidentally arise due to the presence of said camps in the center of Quezon City;


WHEREAS, considering the strategic location of the two camps, if relocated, can be converted into private assets and help raise funds for our government.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to recommend, as it does hereby recommend to his Excellency President Benigno Simeon C. Aquino III and the Secretary of the National Defense to study the transfer of Camp General Emilio Aguinaldo and Camp Crame from Quezon City to a less populated area outside of Metropolitan Manila, to avoid possible loss of lives and damage to property of the people living within the vicinity of said camps.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to send this Resolution to his Excellency, President Benigno Simeon C. Aquino III, and furnish a copy thereof to the Secretary of National Defense, Manila.
