A RESOLUTION URGING ALL THE ESTABLISHMENTS INCLUDING ALL BARANGAYS AND GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN QUEZON CITY TO SYNCHRONIZE THEIR TIME DEVICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE QUEZON CITY STANDARD TIME (QCST).

WHEREAS, synchronizing the time in the city will help people manage their time wisely to be productive, value punctuality, reduce cases of tardiness and progress in business transactions;

WHEREAS, time synchronization is important to provide a frame of reference among the time devices within the city;

WHEREAS, Presidential Decree No.1149, assigned PAGASA as the official agency that will handle the dissemination of the Philippine Standard Time (PST). One of PAGASA's eight (8) major units, the Atmospheric, Geophysical and Space Sciences Branch (AGSSB), operates and maintains a timing system through its Time Service Unit (TSU).

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge all the establishments including all barangays and government offices in Quezon City to synchronize their time devices in accordance with the Quezon City Standard Time (QCST).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to all offices, departments, barangays and other concerned establishments in Quezon City, for their information and compliance.
