A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT RESOURCES AND COORDINATING OFFICE (GAD-RCO) TO CONDUCT SEMINARS RELATING TO WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S RIGHTS FOR BARANGAY OFFICIALS, LUPONG TAGAPAMAYAPA, OFFICERS OF THE WOMEN'S DESKS AND OTHER EMPLOYEES DIRECTLY ASSISTING WOMEN AND CHILDREN IN THEIR LEGAL NEEDS.

WHEREAS, numerous national laws were enacted for the benefit of women and children such as Republic Act No. 9262, otherwise known as the Anti-Violence Against Women and Children, Republic Act No. 9344, otherwise known as the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act and other similar laws;

WHEREAS, the provisions of these laws are sufficient, beneficial and timely to the increasing violations committed against women and children;

WHEREAS, the implementation and manner of assistance are crucial and must be given due attention for it will determine the effectivity and adequacy of the provisions;

WHEREAS, our barangay officials, Lupong Tagapamayapa, officials of the women's desks and other employees directly assisting women and children must be equipped and prepared in delivering services under the laws of our country;

WHEREAS, the Gender and Development Resource and Coordinating Office (GAD-RCO) was created by the City Council to assist in the formulation and monitoring of GAD plans, programs and projects; conduct capacity-building and advocacy activities for gender awareness, gender planning and budgeting and gender mainstreaming in line with the city's mission-vision;
