RESOLUTION NO. SP- **5202**, S-2011

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ATTY. MOISES S. SAMSON, A FORMER MEMBER OF THE SANGGUNILANG PANLUNGSOD, QUEZON CITY AND ITS MAJORITY FLOOR LEADER FOR THE CONTINUOUS YEARS FROM 1995 TO 1998, WHO SUFFERED ACUTE PHYSICAL STROKE, IN ANY AMOUNT FOR HIS MEDICAL AND OTHER RELATED EXPENSES.**

*WHEREAS, Section 458 (1) (xi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" forcibly declares:*

*"When the finances of the city government allow, provide for additional allowances and other benefits to judges, prosecutors, public elementary and high school teachers, and other national government officials STATIONED IN OR ASSIGNED TO THE CITY."*

*WHEREAS, Atty. Moises S. Samson was a member of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Quezon City in the year 1992 to 1998. He served as Minority Floor Leader from 1992 to 1995 and as Majority Floor Leader from 1995 to 1998;*

*WHEREAS, Atty. Moises S. Samson proposed several ordinances and resolutions and thereafter, such measures were passed, approved or adopted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Quezon City, including giving tax relief to those Quezon City's delinquent taxpayers, which the Quezon City Government earned several millions of pesos. There was then giving tax relief to the taxpayers and at the same time, the Quezon City Government earned pesos for its operations and projects;*

*WHEREAS, Atty. Moises S. Samson was the first one in the whole country who proposed an ordinance and the same was approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Quezon City prohibiting the use of cellular phone and other gadgets while driving a motor vehicle to avoid vehicular accidents;*

*WHEREAS, Atty. Moises S. Samson served as a bonafide member of the Peace and Order Council of Quezon City from 2001 to 2010, who regularly performed the duties and functions appurtenant thereto;*

*WHEREAS, Atty. Moises S. Samson, as a practicing lawyer and a law professor since 1979, legally assists the Local Government Unit of Quezon City in solving some matters for its benefit and protection;*

*WHEREAS, on June 14, 2008 up to July 14, 2008, Atty. Moises S. Samson suffered acute physical stroke and from such date, he was hospitalized for which he paid for more than One Million Pesos (P1,000,000.00). For such physical stroke, he was also hospitalized at UST Medical Center and Metropolitan Hospital. To date, he is still detained from his borrowed damaged manual wheelchair and still visits the Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital, three (3) times a week for his physical rehabilitation;*

*WHEREAS, due to such hospitalization and physical rehabilitation including medicines and regular doctor's check-up, he has already incurred Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00), excluding the foregoing amount;*


*WHEREAS, Atty. Moises S. Samson emphatically stated to this representation that he will stop said physical rehabilitation including medicines and other similar things because of lack of funds. X*

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant financial assistance to Atty. Moises S. Samson, a former Member of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Quezon City and its Majority Floor Leader for the continuous years from 1995 to 1998, who suffered acute physical stroke, in any amount for his medical and other related expenses.


