RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BATISTA TO CONSTRUCT ONE (1) DISTRICT PUBLIC LIBRARY IN EVERY DISTRICT IN QUEZON CITY, THE FUND TO BE TAKEN FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE FUND OR ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the rights of all citizens to quality education at all levels and must take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, based on a survey conducted by the Quezon City Public Library, 77% of the users of the library are students, mostly coming from the different public schools in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, due to the populated number of students in the city's public schools, most of the students resort to avail the service of the City Public Libraries for their research works;


WHEREAS, most of the students with research works travel from their places going to the main library located at Quezon City Hall compound causing additional burden to them in terms of time and expenses;

WHEREAS, the establishment of one (1) District Public Library in every district of Quezon City will be very useful not only to the students but to all constituents in their respective areas, notwithstanding the fact that there are a growing numbers of library users every year. It will be a relevant response to the educational problems of poor Filipino children, particularly the lack of learning materials and the difficulty in accessing these materials.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to construct one (1) District Public Library in every district of Quezon City, the fund to be taken from the Infrastructure Fund or any available funds of the City Treasury.
