RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5248, S-2011

**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO CONGRESS THE ENACTMENT OF A LAW PROVIDING FOR THE INCREASE OF THE SHARE FOR THE SPECIAL EDUCATION FUND FROM ONE PERCENT (1%) TO ONE POINT FIVE PERCENT (1.5%) FROM THE REAL PROPERTY TAX COLLECTION FOR THE DISPOSITION OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.**

*WHEREAS, the existing Real Property Tax for the Special Education Fund (SEF) is only 1% of the regular Real Property Tax which is apparently insufficient and inadequate to cover for the increasing expenditures necessary to sustain the delivery of quality education in our public schools, particularly taking into consideration the rapidly growing school enrollment every year;*

*WHEREAS, the increase to 1.5% of the share for Real Property Tax for the Special Education Fund will certainly go a long way to relieve or at least lighten the heavy burden of local government units in maintaining a sustained quality education in public schools within their respective jurisdiction. X*

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED,** to recommend, as it does hereby recommend to Congress the enactment of a law providing for the increase to one point five percent (1.5%) share of the Real Property Tax for the Special Education Fund to cover the delivery of quality education in the public schools within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City.
