RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5310, S-2011

**A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE 142 BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY TO ORGANIZE AND STRENGTHEN THEIR BARANGAY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (BCPC) IN COMPLIANCE WITH QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-1623, S-2005 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A BARANGAY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN IN EVERY BARANGAY IN QUEZON CITY" AND TO CREATE THEIR INTERVENTION AND DIVERSION PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN.**

*WHEREAS, the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children is tasked to promote the best interest of children by preparing and implementing action plans focused on children as well as ensuring that laws and ordinances on children are enforced. It is also assigned to prepare an annual progress report on the situation of children as well as cases affecting children;*

*WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. SP-1623, S-2005 mandates the Punong Barangay of the different Barangays to organize, create and strengthen the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children in coordination with the city's Social Services and Development Department and the Department of the Interior and Local Government and other concerned government and non-government agencies in the area;*

WHEREAS, the key performance indicators of a functional council such as Institutionalization and Enforcement of Plans and Policies, Quick Response, Capability Building, Organizing Children Sector, Coordination of Local Initiatives and Development and Replication of Programs of Barangay Council for the Protection of Children are not given enough commitment, cooperation and collective action of the Barangay Council.

NOW, THEREFORE,


