**A RESOLUTION URGING THE CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF GULOD HIGH SCHOOL, BARANGAY GULOD, QUEZON CITY.**

*WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XIV of the Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the rights of all citizens to quality education at all levels and must take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all*

*WHEREAS, the City's education programs are instruments by which our young people can be assisted to raise themselves from poverty to an empowered life;*

*WHEREAS, for the School Year 2009-2010, a total of 151,396 students in Quezon City were enrolled in high school, wherein 89,829 students thereof came from the 2<sup>nd</sup> District;*

*WHEREAS, District 2, however, is the most populous and congested and the ratio of 67:1 for high school is still high despite construction of additional buildings;*

*WHEREAS, with the ever increasing number of public school enrollees, especially in the high school level, the pressure is continually on the city government to construct more school buildings to provide a comfortable student-to-academic classroom ratio;*

WHEREAS, in order to decongest the ever increasing enrollment of high school students in District 2, it is now extremely necessary to established additional high schools in the various Barangay in District 2, Quezon City.
