RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5322, S-2011

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY RECOMMENDING TO CONGRESS THE REVIEW, REVISION, AMENDMENT AND/ OR REPEAL OF LAWS PROVIDING FOR THE BARANGAY AND SANGGUNLANG KABATAAN ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, it appears that there are many sectors which are clamoring for the scrapping of the present system of Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan elections, in the light of the numerous negative and adverse reports on the recently concluded elections last October 25, 2010;

WHEREAS, the good intention and lofty ideals which we hoped to achieve by holding the Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan elections, were over shadowed and submerged under the general observation of many that the barangay and SK elections tended to erode, destroy and break the good Filipino tradition of strong and close family ties and relations, where members of the same family were pitted against each other as candidates for the same elected Barangay or SK positions, thereby resulting in the erosion and breaking up of close family ties which was forgotten in the heat of the election campaign and desire to win. While we hoped to train our youth for leadership and responsible citizenship, we only exposed them at such early age to the evils of graft and corruption, dishonestly and cheating;
