RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5325, S-2011

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE QUEZON CITY DIVISION OF CITY SCHOOLS TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION ORDER NUMBER 8, SERIES OF 2007, ENTITLED "THE REVISED IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES ON THE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT OF SCHOOL CANTEENS IN PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS" AND TO INCLUDE THE QUEZON CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AS MEMBER OF THE MONITORING AND ENFORCEMENT TEAM.

WHEREAS, malnutrition is an underrated challenge to the development of a child's health and may lead to serious damage to his physiological and intellectual progress;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge the Quezon City Division of City Schools to strictly implement the Department of Education Order Number 8, Series of 2007, entitled "The Revised Implementing Guidelines on the Operation and Management of School Canteens in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools" and to include the Quezon City Health Department as member of the Monitoring and Enforcement Team.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution and the Department of Education Order No. 8, Series of 2007 be provided to the City Health Department, the Division of City Schools and the Principals of the Public Schools for their information and reference.
