RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5352, S-2011

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CITY BUDGET DEPARTMENT TO ALLOW THE DISBURSEMENT FOR THE PAYMENTS OF SALARIES, WAGES AND UTILITIES PENDING THE REVIEW AND CONFIRMATION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE PROPOSED 2011 SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET OF THE CONCERNED BARANGAYS.

WHEREAS, most of the barangays have enacted their Supplemental Budget for 2011 to appropriate funds for their estimated expenditures which are not included in their annual budget like the payment for utilities (electricity and telephone bills, etc.) and other barangay benefits which occurred only in the later part of the year;

WHEREAS, Section 320 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, explicitly provides that "~~x-x-x~~ An ordinance enacting a Supplemental Budget, however, shall take effect upon its approval or on the date fixed therein."; X

WHEREAS, the afore-quoted provision of the law clearly states that upon approval by the sangguniang barangay of their supplemental budget, in effect, they can validly enforce the same to deal with the expenditures necessary to carry out the functions, projects and activities of the barangay;


WHEREAS, nonetheless, this resolution is not intended to circumvent other statutory or administrative procedures but only to address the urgent necessity of the barangays to prevent delays or drawbacks in the efficient delivery of public service.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge the City Budget Department to allow the disbursement for the payments of salaries, wages and utilities pending the review and confirmation by the City Council of the proposed 2011 Supplemental Budget of the concerned barangays.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to direct all concerned department/offices of the Quezon City Government to allow the release or disbursement of funds of the concerned barangays as appropriated in their approved Supplemental Budget for 2011.
