RESOLUTION NO. SP- **5367**, S-2011

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES TO AMEND SECTION 100 (C-3) OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160, THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, SO AS TO INCLUDE THE BOY SCOUTING MOVEMENT AND OTHER MAJOR EXTRA CURRICULAR SCHOOL ACTIVITIES THAT SHALL BE GIVEN PRIORITY IN THE UTILIZATION OF THE ANNUAL SCHOOL BOARD BUDGET IN ADDITION TO SPORTS ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, under Section 235 of Republic Act No. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, a province or city or a municipality within the Metropolitan Manila Area, may levy and collect an annual tax of one percent (1%) on the assessed value of real property which shall be in addition to the basic real property tax. The proceeds thereof shall exclusively accrue to the Special Education Fund (SEF);

WHEREAS, Section 272 of the said Code provides for the application of proceeds of the additional one percent (1%) SEF tax, in the manner as follows;

"Section 272. Application of Proceeds of the Additional One Percent SEF Tax. - The proceeds from the additional one percent (1%) tax on real property accruing to the SEF shall be automatically released to the local school boards: Provided, That, in case of provinces, the proceeds shall be divided equally between the provincial and municipal school boards: Provided, however, That the proceeds shall be allocated for the operation and maintenance of public schools, construction and repair of school buildings, facilities and equipment, educational research, purchase of books and periodicals, and sports development as determined and approved by the local school board."

WHEREAS, Section 100 (c) of the Code provides that:

"(c) The annual school board budget shall be given priority to the following:

- 1. Construction, repair, and maintenance of school buildings and other facilities of public elementary and secondary schools;*
- 2. Establishment and maintenance of extension classes where necessary; and*
- 3. Sports activities at the division, district, municipal, and barangay levels."*

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines which is a public corporation duly organized and existing pursuant to law, has been involved not only in promoting character development, providing adequate citizenship training and leadership among the Filipino youth of the country, but inculcating in them love of country, civic consciousness and responsibility, courage and discipline and similar other virtue and moral values;

WHEREAS, prominent among the activities and services conducted by this Council are those which are geared towards the promotion of the moral, spiritual and physical well-being of the youth, the development of the government among many others;

WHEREAS, in order to strengthen the boy scout movement in the Philippines, various programs and projects have been approved annually which would need the assistance of the government in the promotion and implementation thereof, thereby, in the process, paving the way in the realization of the mission and vision of the movement in the country.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Congress of the Philippines to amend Section 100 (c-3) of Republic Act No. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, so as to include the boy scouting movement and other major extracurricular school activities that shall be given priority in the utilization of the annual school board budget in addition to sports activities.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution to the City Mayor of Quezon City, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, Honorable Feliciano Belmonte, Jr., and the Senate President, Honorable Juan Ponce Enrile.
