RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5388, S-2011

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE FIFTEENTH CONGRESS OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE IMMEDIATE PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL NUMBER 4353, ALSO KNOWN AS THE ANDRES BONIFACIO ACT, PROPOSED BY KABATAAN PARTYLIST REPRESENTATIVE RAYMOND PALATINO.

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the state recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being and along with it, to inculcate youth patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, Section 21 Article XVI, of the same Constitution, states that, "The state shall establish, maintain and support a complete, adequate and integrated system of education relevant to the needs of the people";

WHEREAS, the fundamental components of Filipino citizenship, which include national independence, self-determination, patriotism, civic consciousness and collective action, are imbued by our Filipino Hero, Gat Andres Bonifacio, the leader of the Kataastaasang Kagalanggalangang Katipunan ng mga Anak ng Bayan or KKK, during the 1896 Philippine Revolution;

WHEREAS, it is unfortunate that the youth of today lack full understanding and knowledge of being a true Filipino including the life and contributions of our hero Andres Bonifacio;

WHEREAS, the proposed House Bill No. 4353 or the Andres Bonifacio Act mandates the creation of a mandated course focusing on the study of the life and works of Gat Andres Bonifacio by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) in all higher educational institutions.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge the 15th Congress of the Philippines to enact House Bill No. 4353 or the Andres Bonifacio Act proposed by Kabataan Partylist Representative Raymond Palatino.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to the members of the House of Representatives and the Senate of the Philippines for their information.
