**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT WITH THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION (PHILHEALTH) ADOPTING THE PARTIAL SUBSIDY SCHEME OF THE SPONSORED PROGRAM COMPONENT OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (NHIP).**


*WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the state to adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to the health department, which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and social services available to all citizens at affordable cost;*

*WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essentials to the promotion of the general welfare";*

*WHEREAS, the implementation of Republic Act No. 7875, creation of the National Health Insurance Program as amended by Republic Act No. 9241, particular under its Indigent Sector Component, will redound to the benefit of the indigents of our population taking into account the minimal amount of contributions;*

*WHEREAS, Section 29, Rule IV of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. No. 7875, as amended, provides that "the partial subsidy scheme may be adapted for indigents who are proposed to be enrolled by the LGU or premium donor but do not qualify for full subsidy under the means test rule";*

*WHEREAS, recognizing the need to reach more families to avail the basic package of needed personal health benefits, the local government unit of Quezon City signified the intention to enroll identified local constituents under the Partial Subsidy Scheme in accordance with Philhealth Board Resolution No. 1479 "the implementation of the Partial Subsidy Scheme" series of 2011 and Philhealth Board Resolution No. 1571 series of 2011.*




**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement in behalf of the Quezon City Government, with the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) to adopt and implement the Partial Subsidy Scheme of the Sponsored Program Component of the National Health Insurance Program, for the health benefits of the Quezon City would be beneficiaries.**
