RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5514, S-2012

A RESOLUTION ENJOINING THE COMMISSION ON ELECTION (COMELEC) QUEZON CITY TO FULLY IMPLEMENT SECTION 10 OF RESOLUTION NO. 9149, PROVIDING FOR AN "EXPRESS LANES FOR ELDERLY, DISABLED, DETAINEES AND PREGNANT APPLICANTS, OR THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE RESUMPTION OF THE SYSTEM OF CONTINUING REGISTRATION OF VOTERS AND VALIDATION OF REGISTRATION RECORDS IN THE NON-ARMM AREAS."

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 9149 or the Rules and Regulations for the Resumption of the System of Continuing Registration of Voters and Validation of Registration Records in the Non-ARMM Areas was promulgated by the COMELEC on 11 February 2011;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Resolution No. 9149 provides that: "Applications for registration, transfer of registration records, change/corrections of entries in the registration records, reactivation of registration records and inclusion of registration records/reinstatement of name in the list of voters, shall be personally filed beginning April 1, 2011 to October 31, 2012 at the Office of the Election Officer (OEO) of the city/municipality where the applicant resides, from Monday to Saturday, inclusive of holidays during regular office hours at 8:00 o'clock a.m. to 5:00 o'clock p.m."

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Resolution No. 9149 mandates the provision of "Express Lanes for Elderly, Disabled, Detainees and Pregnant Applicants";

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Resolution No. 9149 mandates that the Office of the Election Officer shall provide during the registration period express lane and give priority/preferential treatment to persons with disabilities, elderly, detainees and pregnant applicants;

WHEREAS, fully implementing Section 10 would enable the senior citizens and the elderly, as well as the disabled, detainees and pregnant applicants the opportunity to exercise their right to suffrage.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to enjoin, as it does hereby enjoin the Commission on Election (Comelec) Quezon City to fully implement Section 10 of Resolution No. 9144, providing for an "Express Lanes for Elderly, Disabled, Detainees and Pregnant Applicants", or the Rules and Regulations for the Resumption of the System of Continuing Registration of Voters and Validation of Registration Records in the Non-ARMM areas."
