A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, AS THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO ESTABLISH THE QUEZON CITY EARLY CHILDHOOD ASSESSMENT, INTERVENTION AND PLACEMENT CENTER (QC-ECAIPC) FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Section 13 of Article II of the Constitution provides that the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social-well being;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7277, also known as the Magna Carta for Disabled Persons, provides for the rehabilitation, self-development and self-reliance of disabled persons and their integration into the mainstream of society for other purposes, rights and privileges of disabled persons including access to quality education;

WHEREAS, the early years are the foundation of a child's healthy development and readiness for lifelong learning especially for children with special needs;

WHEREAS, the Special Education Division (SPED) of the Division of City Schools of Quezon City, came up with a proposed Early Childhood Assessment Intervention and Placement Program for Commonwealth Elementary School as the pilot center; y


WHEREAS, the Quezon City Early Childhood Assessment, Intervention and Placement Center (QC-ECAIPC) will serve as a center for the psycho-educational assessment, intervening and placement program of underprivileged Children with Special Needs (CSN's) who are to enter public schools;

WHEREAS, every child with special needs has a right to an educational program as guaranteed by the fundamental law that is suitable to his/her needs as education is the major trust of the City Government and the Division of City Schools.


NOW, THEREFORE,
