A RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepEd) TO INCLUDE IN THE CURRICULUM OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS A SUBJECT ON CHILDREN'S RIGHTS.

WHEREAS, the Department of Education (DepEd) is the government agency primarily responsible for the formulation, planning, implementation and coordination of the policies, plans, programs and projects in the areas of formal and non-formal education at all levels;

WHEREAS, the Congress of the Philippines have enacted several legislation promoting, respecting and protecting children's rights, such as the Family Code of the Philippines, the ECCD Act, the Special Protection of Children Against Child Abuse, Exploitation and Discrimination Act, Anti-Violence Against Women and their Children Act of 2004, Anti-Child Pornography Act of 2009, and other similar issuances;

WHEREAS, in order to educate and inform children on the existence of these laws, there is a need for the same to be taught in schools, which is the most basic vehicle for teaching and learning;




NOW, THEREFORE,
