RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5546, S-2012

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL NO. 5507, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ACT GRANTING SECURITY OF TENURE UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS TO GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES WHOSE NATURE OF APPOINTMENT IS EITHER TEMPORARY OR CONTRACTUAL AND WHO HAVE RENDERED A TOTAL TEN (10) YEARS OF EFFICIENT SERVICE" AUTHORED BY CONGRESSWOMAN JANE TAN-CASTRO OF CAPIZ PROVINCE.

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 5507 seeks to grant appropriate civil service eligibility to casual or contractual employees in the government who have continuously served therein for at least ten (10) years;

WHEREAS, casual and contractual employees of the government are part of the civil service. They are likewise employed on the basis of their qualification or merit and fitness. They are, however, cannot be given permanent appointment due to lack of appropriate civil eligibility;

WHEREAS, in 1990, Republic Act No. 6850 was passed granting civil service eligibility to government employees appointed under probation or temporary status who have rendered a total of seven (7) years of efficient service;
