A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO PETRON MADRID SERVICE STATION FOR THE RENOVATION AND MAJOR REHABILITATION OF THE GASOLINE SERVICE STATION LOCATED AT KATIPUNAN AVENUE CORNER AURORA BOULEVARD, LOYOLA HEIGHTS, DISTRICT III, QUEZON CITY.

San Gabriel, is applying for the issuance of a Special Use Permit (SUP) for the renovation and major rehabilitation of the gasoline service station located at Katipunan Avenue corner Aurora Boulevard, Loyola Heights, District III, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the operation and major renovation of a gasoline service station are among the uses which require a Special Use Permit upon authorization from the Quezon City Council as provided in Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, otherwise known as the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2000 as amended;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Loyola Heights and the residents therein interposes no objection to the said project;
