RESOLUTION NO. SP- **5550**, S-2012

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES TO AMEND SECTION 470 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160, THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, SO AS TO INCREASE THE LENGTH OF WORK EXPERIENCE QUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT AS CITY OR PROVINCIAL TREASURER FROM FIVE(5) TO EIGHT(8) YEARS.

WHEREAS, Section 470 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides:

"SEC. 470. Appointment Qualifications, Powers, and Duties. -

- (a) The treasurer shall be appointed by the Secretary of Finance from a list of at least three (3) ranking eligible recommendees of the governor or mayor, as the case maybe, subject to civil service law, rules and regulations.*
- (b) x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x-x.*
- (c) No person shall be appointed treasurer unless he is a citizen of the Philippines, a resident of the local government unit concerned, of good moral character, a holder of college degree preferably in commerce, public administration or law from a recognized college or university, and a first grade civil service eligible or its equivalent. He must have acquired experience in treasury or accounting service for at least five (5) years in the case of the provincial or city treasurer.*

WHEREAS, the position of city or provincial treasurer is very important because he collects and disburses the local government funds in addition to being the custodial of the said funds, among many others. Hence the appointment to the said position must have acquired the necessary experience, skills and expertise in the treasury and accounting service to face the challenges demanded of the position.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge as it does hereby urge the Congress of the Philippines to amend Section 470 of Republic Act No. 7160, Local Government Code of 1991, so as to increase the length of work experience qualification for appointment as city or provincial treasurer from five(5) to eight(8) years.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this Resolution to Honorable Mayor Herbert M. Bautista, Quezon City, and Speaker Feliciano Belmonte, House of the Representatives, for their information and proper guidance.
