A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING FULL SUPPORT OF THE 18TH CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CELEBRATION OF ELDERLY FILIPINO WEEK WHICH IS CELEBRATED EVERY OCTOBER 1 TO 7 PURSUANT TO PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 470.

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation 470 declared that October 1 to 7 of every year as Elderly Filipino Week;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9994 entitled "An Act Granting Additional Benefits and Privileges to Senior Citizens, further amending Republic Act No. 7432, as amended, otherwise known as "An Act to Maximize the Contribution of Senior Citizens to Nation Building, Grant Benefits and Special Privileges and For Other Purposes" provides the following objective:

- (a) To recognize the rights of senior citizens to take their proper place in society and make it a concern of the family, community, and government;*
- (b) To give full support to the improvement of the total well-being of the elderly and their full participation in society, considering that senior citizens are integral part of Philippine society;*
- (c) To motivate and encourage the senior citizens to contribute to nation building;*

- (d) To encourage their families and the communities they live with to reaffirm the valued Filipino tradition of caring for the senior citizens;
- (e) To provide a comprehensive health care and rehabilitation system for disabled senior citizens to foster their capacity to attain a more meaningful and productive ageing; and
- (f) To recognized the important role of the private sector in the improvement of the welfare of senior citizens and to actively seek their partnership.


WHEREAS, this year's celebration, with the theme "NAKATATANDA: Sa Bisa ng Republic Act No. 9994 may Dangal, Nagkakaisa at Buhay ay Guminhawa" aims to give recognition and free services to our senior citizens in order to motivate and encourage them to continue to actively participate in nation building;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the City Council give its full support to the aforementioned celebration of our Senior Citizens to make them active partners in the development of our city and the entire country.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to express, as it does hereby express the full support of the 18th City Council for the celebration of Elderly Filipino Week which is celebrated every October 1 to 7 pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 470.
