A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF RODRIGUEZ, RIZAL THRU ITS HONORABLE MAYOR CECILIO C. HERNANDEZ FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE RESETTLEMENT OF INFORMAL SETTLERS IN QUEZON CITY TO THE SAID LOCALITY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City has the largest number of Informal Settler Families (ISFs) in the National Capital Region, usually living together under congested and substandard conditions in blighted and danger areas;

WHEREAS, considering the large number of marginal and low income families in Quezon City living in slums and other depressed communities and in dangerous areas such as esteros, canals, dumpsite, rivers and public lands such as parks, roads and playgrounds, their urgent need for shelter requires immediate and continuing response from Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, it is now one of the priority thrusts of the Quezon City Government to provide decent and affordable shelter to those informal settlers; however, considering the limited relocation sites in Quezon City, there is a need to send those informal settlers in the Municipality of Rodriguez, Rizal for resettlement under the housing program of the National Government thru the National Housing Authority;

WHEREAS, in order to formalize the said resettlement project, there is a need for the Quezon City Government to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Local Government of Rodriguez, Rizal for its acceptance and also for its assistance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement in behalf of the Quezon City Government with the Local Government of Rodriguez, Rizal through its Honorable Mayor Cecilio C. Hernandez for the comprehensive resettlement of informal settlers in Quezon City to the said locality.
