RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5622, S-2012

**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING ALL BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY TO CONDUCT SEMINARS ON EFFECTIVE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION.**

*WHEREAS, Metro Manila Earthquake Impact Reduction Study (MMEIRS) conducted by JICA in 2004 revealed that a 7.2 magnitude earthquake in Metro Manila would cause the destruction of the 40% of the residential buildings, damage 35% of all public buildings, kill 34,000 people and injure 114,000 individuals;*

*WHEREAS, Metro Manila is the seventh most vulnerable in Southeast Asia and first in the Philippines in terms of its vulnerability to multiple climate hazards such as cyclones, landslides, earthquakes, floods and droughts;*

*WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines mandates the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;*

*WHEREAS, every Local Government Unit (LGU) has been granted power and authority by Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the Philippines, to promote the general welfare of its constituents to include among others, the promotion of their health and safety. Towards this end, it is the purpose of this Ordinance to safeguard the public health and ensure the physical well being of all its constituents;*

*WHEREAS, Quezon City population of illegal settlers face environmental issues such as the lack of decent housing, poor water, sanitation, sewerage system, and uncoordinated land use planning thereby putting the marginal population in unsafe settlements;*

*WHEREAS, considering the proximity of Quezon City to the Marikina Fault Line, the existence of the La Mesa Dam and Watershed System thereby putting Quezon City at risk of disaster;*

*WHEREAS, Quezon City needs to conduct climate change adaptation and disaster risk reduction seminars to address chaos brought about by natural or man-made calamities.*

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to direct, as it does hereby direct all Barangays of Quezon City to conduct seminars on Effective Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation.**
