WHEREAS, it is the firm belief of this representation that a well-informed and educated employee who is aware of his rights, welfare and development, benefits and privileges is more likely to prevent discrimination and other forms of abuse in the workplace and is therefore vital in nation building.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) to provide Labor Law Seminar for all graduating students of the tertiary level of Quezon City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Labor Law Seminar (LLS) shall be a seminar which shall include, but shall not be limited to, discussions on labor standards, relations, rights and benefits, including the salient features of the Labor Code of the Philippines and its amendments, Maternity Benefits Act, Paternity Leave Act, Solo Parents' Welfare Act, Anti-Sexual Harassment Act, Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act, Anti-Violence Against Women and Children Act, Prohibition on Discrimination Against Women and Children and other Labor Laws.
