RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5625, S-2012

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE OFFICE OF THE CITY TREASURER, IN CLOSE COORDINATION WITH THE QUEZON CITY INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY TO FORMULATE PROGRAMS AND INSTITUTE SECURITY MEASURES TO STOP AND PREVENT THE USE OF FAKE OFFICIAL RECEIPTS IN THE PAYMENT OF REAL PROPERTY TAX, BUSINESS TAX, TRANSFER TAX AND REGULATORY FEES AND CHARGES COLLECTED BY THE CITY TREASURER OR HIS DULY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE.

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of some members of the City Council report on the increasing incidence of fake or counterfeit official receipts being used in the payment of real property tax, transfer tax and regulatory fees and charges in the Office of the City Treasurer;

WHEREAS, these fake or false documents are either forged or falsified documents by making it appear that they are true and genuine when in fact they are not;

WHEREAS, the use of this spurious official receipts is usually done in connivance, conspiracy, consent or cooperation with some unscrupulous city officials/employees to the damage and detriment of the city government which resulted in the failure to collect enormous amount in revenues which should have been otherwise used to help support the city's program on health, education, peace and order and security and similar other basic services including infrastructure.
