RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5673, S-2013.

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. SP-5639, S-2012, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, OF THREE (3) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLES INTENDED FOR MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THE SAID OFFICE AMOUNTING TO TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED FORTY NINE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTEEN PESOS AND FIFTY FOUR CENTAVOS [Php2,249,817.54] TO BE CHARGED TO THE OFFICE OF THE CITY COUNCILORS FUND, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor, through the Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, has requested for the purchase of motor vehicle that will help facilitate the mobility and efficient operation of official duties and functions;

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WHEREAS, the motor vehicles that will be procured described as follows;

Vehicle with seating capacity of 17 individuals, including driver L4 in-line SOHC diesel EURO-2 compliant. Displacement-2477 Bore x stroke 91.1 1x95, compression ratio 21:1 max power ps/rpm 70.72/4200 max torque 140/2500, transmission type manual 5 speed. Suspension front-independent wishbone and coil spring with stabilizer, rear-semi elliptic leaf spring. Brakes front-10" ventilated discs rear-10" leading and trailing drums, brake booster 9" master vacuum, steering gear type ball and nut gear w/power steering wheel 2-spoke polypropylene wheels-14"x5.0j steel rims. Tires 185r14c-pr.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 15 amending Administrative Order No. 233 Series of 2008, the Honorable City Mayor Herbert M. Bautista has already sought permission and authorization from the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) in his letter addressed to Honorable Mar Roxas, DILG Secretary, for the acquisition of the above-described motor vehicles amounting to P2,249,817.54 which amount is included in the 2012 Annual Budget of the City Government under the City Council;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Act of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance; ✕



NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the Office of the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, Quezon City, to purchase three (3) units of motor vehicles intended for monitoring of programs and projects of said office, amounting to Two Million Two Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Seventeen Pesos and Fifty Four Centavos. (Php2,249,817.54) to be charged to the office of the City Councilors Fund, Quezon City.
